Everything is Up from Here

My name is Iona. I'm 27 years old and a mother of 4 kids, all under 10. When I first came to St. Stephen Housing, my newest baby was only 2 weeks old and I was still having trouble moving after giving birth via C-section. Those first couple months were so hard; I struggled with postpartum depression and was having difficulty healing properly from the birth. However, I kept working with my Housing Case Manager, Marissa. She encouraged me to keep going, keep trying; she brought me job applications and helped me find a doctor who could help

me. With all the support, I kicked postpartum in the teeth. She also helped me to stay on top of the all the medical appointments for my oldest, who has a brain injury. I interviewed for a couple of jobs and didn't get them. My depression started settling in again but I told myself to keep going. Marissa would come by while I cried and tell me to hang in there and keep going. She even was there for a second interview for a job and held my screaming and upset baby while I did the interview over zoom. When I was finally

hired for a job, SSHA helped pay for the documents I needed to obtain and for gas to get there the first week. I feel like I'm finally coming out of this depression and finding myself. It feels like everything is up from here and I don't plan nor will I fail. I'm doing this for me and my children, so we don't have to depend on anyone else ever again. I'm thankful for everything you all have done for me. It wouldn't have been possible without the help of St. Stephen Housing.

ARE YOU INTERESTED IN HELPING PUT ON OUR ANNUAL FUNDRAISER?

Our new Housing Stability Program launched in 2023. This program enables us to assist families to maintain housing stability through rental or utility assistance. We have a small amount of funds to serve families living in the following cities: Des Moines, Seatac, Renton and Covington.

Our primary focus is to serve households that:

- May not have access to or knowledge of other resources
- Demonstrate a specific hardship causing a need for assistance
- Have income below 60% AMI
- Owe no more than \$1000 in rent, if needing rental assistance
- Have a past due utility bill

St. Stephen Housing continues to partner with King County and United Way of King County to provide rental assistance to thousands of households facing eviction due to economic struggles caused by the pandemic. Since 2021 we have distributed over \$17 million in rental assistance to keep over 1600 households in their housing.
